Knowledge of advanced statistical methods and/or machine learning techniques, data base management and data visualization. Ability to analyse data, perform statistical analysis and interpret results. Experience with statistical software packages and good programming skills in R and/or Python. Strong programming skills. Ability to read scientific publications and implement mathematical algorithms. Good interpersonal skills. Ability to effectively communicate and present research ideas to researchers and stakeholders with different backgrounds. Demonstrated high level written and oral communication skills. Demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a collaborative research team.
