Requisites

Promising young researchers. Applicants must have their PhD completed before the starting date. PhD degree preferable in Statistics, Biostatistics or related fields. Good interpersonal skills. A proven track record in quality research, as evidenced by research publications in top scientific journals and conferences. Demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a collaborative research team. Ability to present and publish research outcomes in spoken (talks) and written (papers) form. Ability to effectively communicate and present research ideas to researchers and stakeholders with different backgrounds. Fluency in spoken and written English. Strong background in (frequentist or Bayesian) statistical modelling and inference. Demonstrated knowledge in semiparametric and nonparametric regression techniques as well as sparse regression. Good programming skills in R, Python and/or MATLAB. Research experience in applied Statistics in interdisciplinary applications (e.g.: Medicine, Biology or Agriculture). Interest and disposition to participate in knowledge transfer projects with research entities.
