Collaborate in the methodological design of new group research projects to guarantee their scientific validity. Participate in the development of new network research projects to meet the objectives defined in the priority lines of work of the programs. Support to the request management of the new projects that are requested derived from the programs or work packages, with the intention of requesting at least one new bi-annual project. Collaborate in the statistical analysis and dissemination of the results obtained both in the network projects led by the group and in the network projects in which you collaborate. Contribute to the transfer of results to clinical practice, deepening in a special way the aspects of implementation of the evidence generated. Active and continuous search for public and private research calls that may interest the group. Implement dissemination actions of the IPIAP projects, training and organizational actions for the collaborating teams, as well as provide advice on the implementation of their sub-projects and / or activity related to the work packages of the programs.

Requisites

Postgraduate training in epidemiology and / or biostatistics and / or quantitative / qualitative research methods. Experience in the design, execution and management of research projects.
