Main functions, requisites & benefits

Main functions

To select and the recruitment of patients for inclusion in the study in collaboration with the research team. To complete questionnaires (general, quality of life, dyspnea, limitations of daily life, anxiety and depression, physical activity). To carry out a walking test. Muscle strength measurements (you must know and handle the Biodex device properly). To measure physical activity (management of accelerometers). To measure of the body composition by bioimpedance. To design, management and update databases together with the clinical team. To complete the databases (introduction of clinical data) and their maintenance up to date. To review entered data and debugging. To cite patients and control the study of agenda. To coordinate with the other services and units of the other measurements to be carried out during the study. To organize, carry out and supervise field work. To review clinical data from the electronic medical record (Osabide). To prepare periodic reports. To participate in the meetings of the research team and the project coordinating committee.

Requisites

Licensed or Graduate in Health Sciences (Medicine, Nursing, Biology) preferably. Minimum experience of 2 years in carrying out measurements, monitoring and coordination in clinical studies in health services. Minimum experience of 2 years in database management. Eligibility Criteria: Previous experience in similar projects in patients with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease. Previous experience in similar projects in patients with chronic diseases. This previous experience must be supported by reports and preferably by publications (50%). Previous experience in the tasks to be carried out and listed below (10%). Previous experience in handling the devices related to this project (10%). Ability to organize and coordinate with other services and units of the hospital and with other research groups in other hospitals (5%). Certificate of disability at least 33% (5%). Knowledge in the maintenance and debugging of Access databases or other databases, and handling of spreadsheets (5%). Knowledge of the RedCap database (5%).
