Main functions

Role and Responsibilities. You will work as a research assistant at Orkestra with the following role and responsibilities: You will be a member of the working team in charge of the Culture as an Economic Driver project. You will support the knowledge co-generation processes launched in collaboration with the Basque Cultural Observatory. You will participate in the analyses arising from the work of the project. You will carry out an industrial PhD in a subject related to the project. Furthermore, the successful applicant will seek to identify the synergies of the project with other lines of action and research projects implemented by Orkestra.

Requisites

Ideal candidates should have a Bachelor's degree either in Political Science, Sociology, Social Psychology, Communications, Economics and Business Management or other social sciences. The candidate must either be pursuing a doctorate in a subject related to the project Culture as an Economic Driver or must fulfil the academic requirements to start one in the academic year 2021-2022. Applicants should have previous experience of participating in applied research projects. Fluency in spoken and written English, Basque and Spanish is required. Skills and competencies required: Knowledge and competencies in fields related to the project and the ability to write reports which include conceptualizations and policy recommendations will be assets to the team. Also highly appreciated is the candidate's ability to write research articles with the aim of publishing them in academic journals with a high impact factor and he/she being interested in doing so. Knowledge of quantitative research techniques, software and database management will be welcome. Other desirable qualities are possessing excellent teamwork skills and a capacity to build networks with stakeholders and collaborators. We are looking for a person who is enthusiastic about new ways of working collaboratively in an open academic environment. Moreover, the successful candidate must be able to build constructive relationships in the workplace as well as with the relevant actors for territorial competitiveness. Finally, good communication skills are a bonus. We are looking for a person with cultural awareness and sensitivity, who is also active in the Basque cultural field.
