By analysing if extreme populist parties are acting as niche parties, substantively representing (but also twisting) the needs and demands of citizens at the margins, UNTWIST will co-create alternative ways of addressing those citizens. The study has a comparative nature (Spain, Denmark, Germany, Hungary, Switzerland and UK) with partners from all these countries in the consortium. Research topic. Political Science and Gender studies. Objectives of the position/Tasks Literature review and conceptual work within the work packages of the UNTWIST project. Planning and coordination of the implementation of the comparative survey (construction of tools, cooperation with research agencies, etc.). Analysis and interpretation of quantitative and qualitative data within the framework of the work packages. Collaboration in the elaboration of deliverables and dissemination reports of the results obtained in the framework of the project, including research articles, presentations at conferences, scientific dissemination works. Research orientation in the fields of democracy studies, preferably political culture, populism, political attitudes and values, and gender studies. Familiarity with quantitative methods, including survey design and administration and quantitative data analysis. Knowledge of statistical packages used in the social sciences (R, Stata, SPSS). General knowledge of qualitative methodology.
