## Main functions, requisites & benefits

### Main functions

To develop the different active RICAPPS projects led by the group or in which the group is involved, as well as to monitor the progress of the activities described in the work packages, their deliverables and milestones. Supervise the implementation of the active projects and support the field work of the projects in which the group is involved (e.g. recruitment, data collection, testing and follow-up of the subjects included in the studies, etc.). Likewise, to participate in the coordination of the different activities required in each project. Collaborate in the design and methodological development of the group's new research projects and guarantee their scientific validity so that they meet the previously defined objectives of the RICAPPS and the group's priority lines. Support in funding applications for new projects derived from the programmes or work packages, with the intention of applying for at least one project per year during 2025-2027. Collaborate in the statistical analysis and dissemination of the results obtained in the network projects led by the group, as well as in the network projects in which the group participates, by writing scientific articles and other scientific communication products. Intra-group and inter-group coordination of all the actions implicit in participation in the network, including the holding and/or participation in meetings that stimulate the active collaboration of the different groups in the projects and lines of the RICAPPS. Coordinate the participation of the Clinical Care Group in the network's projects and their integration into the group's strategy and research network. Regular maintenance of the group's research support resources and structures (exercise laboratories equipped with cycle-ergometers, accelerometers, etc.). Active and continuous search for public and private research calls that may be of interest to the group.

### Requisites

Requirements: Advanced degree in medicine, pharmacy, psychology, sociology, statistics, economics, nursing or other health-related sciences. 1 year of experience in the design, execution and/or management of research projects. Knowledge of English (minimum B2 EOI or similar). Eligibility criteria: 100 points: PhD or postgraduate training in epidemiology and/or biostatistics and/or quantitative/qualitative research methods (0-40). Scientific publications (0-30). Experience in the use of statistical analysis software, such as SAS, STATA, R or similar (0-25). Certificate of disability minimum 33% (0-5)
